
## **Ground Floor**

Chatsworth House is a large house with light and dark rooms. At Christmas time, the house is busy with lots of visitors. If you need any help, you can ask a member of staff. You can ask to use a quiet space if you need to. You can borrow ear defenders from the entrance hall.

This map is designed to let you know where there is additional lighting, sound and smells on the visitor route.

If you are using a wheelchair, a member of staff will show you where there is a lift.


- 1 You will enter the house through a marquee. There are benches for sitting on and shadows from trees.
- 2 North Entrance Hall: there are trees with lighting. There are projections of fairies and the sound of birdsong and butterfly wings.
- 3 North Sub Corridor: there is a sculpture of a woman. There are garlands of leaves and a see through door.
- 4 Painted Hall: there are trees with lighting. There are garlands of leaves. You can hear choral music.
- 5 There is a tunnel of willow and fairy lights. You can hear birdsong and choral music.
- 6 Chapel Corridor: there is a projection of a fairy. There is a tree with lighting. You will walk through an arch made of copper oak leaves.
- 7 Chapel: there is seating you can use. There is the smell of cedar wood. You can hear choral music and the sound of owls.
- 8 Oak Room: there is seating you can use, there is a tree with lighting. You can hear choral music.
- Grotto: there is a tree with lighting.
- 10 The route continues upstairs, ask a guide if you need to use the lift.





## Second Floor

- freat Stairs Landing: there is a projection of a fairy and a tree with lighting.
- Scots Lobby: there is a projection of a fairy. You can hear music.
- (B) Green Satin Dressing Room: if you need a break, ask a guide to use the quiet space.
- Green Satin Room: there is a projection of a fairy. There is a gazebo with paper tags hung on it. You can write a wish tag and tie it to the gazebo.
- (15) Great Chamber: there are trees with lighting. There is the scent of oranges and spice. You can hear woodland sounds. There is a projection of a fairy and a chair you can sit in for a photo.
- South Sketch: you can hear choral music and woodland animals. There are leafy arches.
- West Sketch: you can hear choral music and woodland animals.
- 18 North Sketch: there are leafy garlands and objects in the display cases. Now you will go downstairs. There is also a lift.





## First Floor

- 19 Oak Stairs Landing: there is a large metal sculpture of mistletoe. It is lit up. You can hear choral music from the Painted Hall.
- Library: you can look into the library but cannot enter. There is a tree with lighting.
- 21 Ante-Library: there is a tree with lighting.
  There are candles lighting the space. You can hear birds signing.





## North Wing

- Dining Room: you can hear choral music. You can smell spiced fruit. There is a projection on the ceiling. There is a mirrored table reflecting the ceiling. There are trees with lighting. There is seating you can use.
- Vestibule: there are plants on the tables and a garland around the chandelier with lighting. You can hear music from the dining room.
- There are children's bean bags and a tree with lighting.
- Sculpture gallery: there are giant dandelion heads. There are trees with lighting. You can hear choral music and woodland sounds.
- Gift Shop: there are Christmas decorations. There are scents and music. This shop can be busy. You can walk through the shop to go out into the garden or you can look at things in the shop. The exits to the garden are marked on the glass doors.
